


TOWN ORDINANCE 2007-05

AUTHORIZING THE BORROWING OF FUNDS TO COVER THE COST OF ENGINEERING & DESIGN SERVICES TO CAP THE STATE STREET LANDFILL.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PALMER TOWN COUNCIL THAT:

One hundred and twenty-eight thousand dollars (\$128,000) is appropriated for the cost of engineering services for plans, specifications, bid support and construction oversight for the closure and capping of the State Street Landfill; that to meet this appropriation the Treasurer, with the approval of the Town Manager, is authorized to borrow \$128,000 under G.L. c44 or any other enabling authority; that the Town Manager is authorized to contract for and expend any federal or state aid available for the project, provided that the amount of the authorized borrowing shall be reduced by the amount of such aid received prior to the issuance of bonds or notes under this ordinance; and that the Town Manager is authorized to take any other action necessary to carry out this project.
