
TOWN ORDINANCE 2009-04

AUTHORIZING THE BORROWING OF FUNDS TO COVER THE COST OF ENGINEERING AND DESIGN SERVICES ASSOCIATED WITH PHASE IV OF THE COMBINED SEWER OVERFLOW PROJECT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PALMER TOWN COUNCIL

That up to \$320,000 be appropriated for the purpose of financing engineering, construction and reconstruction of sewers and sewerage systems; including without limitation all costs thereof as defined in of Chapter 29C, §1 of the Massachusetts General Laws; that to meet this appropriation, the Treasurer with the approval of the Town Manager, is authorized to borrow up to \$320,000 and issue bonds or notes therefore under Chapter 44, §7 and/or Chapter 29C of the Massachusetts General Laws; that such bonds or notes shall be general obligations of the Town unless the Treasurer with the approval of the Town Manager determines that they should be issued as limited obligations and may be secured by local system revenues as defined in Chapter 29C, §1; that the Treasurer with the approval of the Town Manager is authorized to borrow all or a portion of such amount from the Massachusetts Water Pollution Abatement Trust, or any other government funds as may be made available through any stimulus package offered by the State or Federal government and in connection therewith to enter into a loan agreement and/or security agreement with the Trust or any other government agencies making funds available through any stimulus package offered by the State or Federal government and to contract with said government agencies and the Department of Environmental Protection with respect to such loan and for any federal or state aid available for the project or for the financing thereof; that the Town Manager is authorized to enter into a project regulatory agreement with the Department of Environmental Protection, to expend all funds available for the project and to take any other action necessary to carry out the project.
