


TOWN ORDINANCE 2011-03

AUTHORIZING THE BORROWING OF FUNDS TO COVER THE COST OF OPM, DESIGN AND CONSTRUCTION ASSOCIATED WITH PALMER PUBLIC SCHOOLS ROOF-BOILER PROJECT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PALMER TOWN COUNCIL

That the sum of four million, forty-eight thousand nine hundred thirty-four dollars (\$4,048,934) be appropriated for Converse Middle School, Palmer High School, Old Mill Pond School in Palmer, MA for the replacement of roofs and boilers, which proposed repair project would materially extend the useful life of the school and preserve an asset that otherwise is capable of supporting the required educational program, said sum to be expended under the direction of the Town Manager, and to meet said appropriation the Town Treasurer, with the approval of the Town Manager, is authorized to borrow said sum under Massachusetts General Laws, Chapter 44, or any other enabling authority; that the Town of Palmer acknowledges that the Massachusetts School Building Authority's (MSBA) grant program is a non-entitlement, discretionary program based on need, as determined by the MSBA, and any project costs that the Town of Palmer incurs in excess of any grant approved by and received from the MSBA shall be the sole responsibility of the Town of Palmer; provided further that any grant that the Town of Palmer may receive from the MSBA for the project shall not exceed the lesser of 61.32% of eligible approved project costs, as determined by the MSBA, or the total maximum grant amount determined by the MSBA; and that the amount of borrowing authorized pursuant to this vote shall be reduced by any grant amount set forth in the Project Funding Agreement that may be executed between the Town of Palmer and the Massachusetts School Building Authority.
