



AMENDMENT TO THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE TOWN OF PALMER

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PALMER TOWN COUNCIL

That the Code of Ordinances of the Town of Palmer, Chapter 171 Zoning, be amended to change the zoning of Converse/ Sherman properties, also known as L8 High Street (Map 7, Lot 8), 1002 High Street (Map 7, Lot 7), L6 High Street (Map 7, Lot 6), L5 French Street (Map 7, Lot 5), 54 Walnut Street (Map 7, Lot 4), and Converse Street (Map 7, Lot 3) from Rural Residential and Suburban Residential Districts to the Highway Business District.
