

**PALMER CONSERVATION COMMISSION
PUBLIC HEARING NOTICE**

In accordance with the Wetland Protection Act of the General Laws of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, Chapter 131, Section 40, and the Town of Palmer Wetlands Bylaws, the Palmer Conservation Commission will hold a public hearing on Tuesday, January 21st at 7:00 PM in the Town Administration Building, Meeting Room #1, 4417 Main Street, Palmer, MA 01069 on the application of Camp Ramah in New England.

The applicant has submitted a Notice of Intent for site improvements including the construction of a building for medical treatment of camp attendants and associated utility service connections. The work is proposed to occur within the 100 foot buffer zone of a bordering vegetated wetland (BVW).

The project is located at 39 Bennett St., Palmer, MA 01069. Assessor's Map 36, Parcel 70.
