

## PALMER CONSERVATION COMMISSION PUBLIC HEARING NOTICE

In accordance with the Wetland Protection Act, MGL c.131 s.40, and the Town of Palmer Wetlands Bylaws, the Conservation Commission will hold a public hearing at 6:30 PM, Tuesday, May 6, 2025 at the Town Administration Building, 4417 Main Street, Palmer, MA to consider a Request for Determination of Applicability for the proposed activities associated with installation of a new six-inch diameter natural gas main along the Park Street right-of-way. Portions of the work area will be located within the 100-foot Buffer Zone to Bordering Vegetated Wetlands and Inland Bank, the locally regulated 50-foot No Disturb Zone, and the 25-foot Riverfront Area. The project area begins at the North Main St./Randall St. intersection, extends within North Main St., Church St., School St. and Park St., and terminates at the Park St./Stone St. intersection. The applicant making the request is SWCA Environmental Consultants, on behalf of Eversource Energy. Any interested person wishing to be heard on the application should appear at the time and place designated. Donald Blais, Jr., Chair, Palmer Conservation Commission.
