This permit is granted to the following restrictions and conditions:

- Water Entrance/Connection Fee = \$950.00* and meter fee, to be paid in full before work begins.
- Fee for subdivisions: \$1045.00 per inch.
- Owner/Applicant will be liable for all expenses incurred for installation including, but not limited to, service materials, excavation costs, permit fees, and road repairs.
- Owner/Applicant and/or his agent shall agree to obtain all applicable permits such as a Dig-Safe Permit, Highway Cross/Alter Permit, Plumbing Permit, etc.
- No Connection will be made to any existing water main unless a perpendicular connection to said main can be achieved and a static pressure of 35 psi can be maintained.
- The new service line shall be constructed of Type K soft copper tubing for services of 1 inch through 2 inches of diameter. With prior approval, 200 psi, copper tube size (CTS) polyethylene tubing may be substituted.
- Cement lined, bituminous coated, Class 52 Ductile Iron pipe with Tyton Joints shall be used for services of 4 inches and larger.
- Owner/Applicant and/or his agent shall agree to abide by all directives of the Bondsville Water Department.
- All buildings or facilities connected to the Public Water System shall be subject to a cross connection survey on a regular basis at the discretion of the Bondsville Water Department.
- Other restrictions may apply depending on the type of facility.
